Summer Student Grounds Maintenance Worker: Wage - \$15 per hour

Hours - 35 hour work week, Monday to Friday 8:30 – 4:30

Work term is from April 30, 2018 to August 24, 2018.

Summer Student Grounds Maintenance Worker: The grounds maintenance worker will take direction from EPW Skilled Labourer and will have experience operating one or more of the following pieces of equipment: lawn tractors, compact tractors, farm tractors, bush hogs, clearing saws, ground compaction equipment, and water pumps. Strong communication and time management skills are a must. Also, needs to make safety a top priority.

General Job duties will be as follows:

- Municipal Greenspace Maintenance - maintenance of existing green spaces which would include but not limited to mowing municipal properties / sidewalk medians, maintaining municipal complex gardens, fertilizing, new planting and restoration of existing, general project management tasks (i.e., maintenance schedule updates), etc;
- General road maintenance such as line painting and signage installation;
- Inspection Services – routine inspections of existing Municipal roads, drainage ways and construction projects.
- Brush cutting / removal;
- General Administration within the Department of Engineering and Public Works.

Job requirements for this position are as follows:

- Enrolled in either a community college / university program;
- Valid driver's license;
- Strong work ethic and ability to work in a team environment;
- Has experience working in a safety sensitive position;
- The successful applicants will need their own safety boots and a valid driver's license.

Note: Travel mileage is reimbursed if own vehicle is used for work. Applicable safety training will be provided.
