The ideal candidate will be in the 3rd or final year of a recognized University or Community College Recreation Management Program with administration and programming experience; however, applicants with equivalent training & experience will also be considered. Previous experience working at or supervising, summer camps will be considered an asset. We are looking for an enthusiastic, organized, and motivated self starter.

Summer Mobile Day camp Leaders: (3) The leaders will plan and deliver day camp activities to the participants (aged 5-12), be responsible for the safety of the participants, and interact with parents and recreation staff.

The ideal camp leader candidate will have prior experience working with youth in a physical activity and/or camp setting will be a high school, college, or university student and will be outgoing, patient, caring and creative.
