6.2 **RECREATIONAL COMMERCIAL (C7) ZONE**

PERMITTED USES IN C7 ZONE

- 6.2.1 The following uses shall be permitted in any C7 Zone:
 - a. **Principal Uses**

Drive-in Theatres Golf Driving Ranges Outdoor Resort and Recreational Complexes Race Tracks Tent and Trailer Campgrounds

b. Uses Subject to Conditions

Single Family Dwellings

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS IN C6 ZONE

6.2.2 Any permitted use in any C7 Zone must comply with the following special requirements:

Single Family Dwellings

6.2.2.1 Single family dwellings are permitted as the principal residence of the owners or managers of a campground or outdoor resort.

Parking Space Ratios

6.2.2.2 a. Outdoor Resort and Recreational Complexes, Tent and Trailer Campgrounds

Parking shall be provided at the rate of one (1) parking space per rental accommodation plus parking for accessory commercial facilities as required in the C1 Zone.

b. Golf Driving Ranges

Parking shall be provided at the rate of one (1) parking space per driving bay.

c. Race Tracks

Parking shall be provided at the rate of one (1) parking space for every two (2) seats.

Parking Standards

- 6.2.2.3 a. No parking area shall be located within twenty (20) feet of a lot line.
 - b. A parking garage or structure as an accessory use may be permitted in a side or rear yard only.
 - c. Parking facilities for more than four (4) vehicles shall comply with the following standards:
 - i. the parking area shall be maintained with a stable surface that is treated to prevent the raising of dust or loose particles.
 - ii. the lights used for illumination of the parking lot or parking station shall be so arranged as to divert the light away from streets, adjacent lots and buildings.
 - a structure, not more than fifteen (15) feet in height and not more than fifty (50) square feet in area may be erected in the parking area for the use of attendants;
 - iv. when the parking area is of a permanent hard surfacing, each parking space shall be clearly demarcated and maintained as such;
 - v. no gasoline pumps or other service station equipment shall be located or maintained on the parking lot.
 - vi. traffic aisles leading to and within parking areas shall be a minimum width of ten (10) feet for one-way traffic, and a minimum width of twenty (20) feet for two-way traffic.

Access

- 6.2.2.4 a. A maximum of two (2) accesses to any lot in a C7 Zone from any public road shall be permitted.
 - b. A minimum fifty (50) foot separation distance consisting of a curb, barrier, or ditch designed to prevent vehicular access shall be maintained between accesses.
 - c. Accesses shall have a maximum width of thirty-six (36) feet.
 - d. Accesses shall be located at least fifty (50) feet from the nearest intersection of street lines.
 - e. Where possible access shall be to an arterial or collector road.

Signs

6.2.2.5 All signs shall be subject to the requirements of 3.2 SIGNS, PART 3 – GENERAL PROVISIONS FOR ALL ZONES.

Swimming Pools

- 6.2.2.6 Swimming pools are permitted as an accessory use provided:
 - a. That no part of any outdoor swimming pool enclosure is located closer than twenty-five feet to any property line.
 - b. That such development is in full conformance with the Municipal Swimming Pool Bylaw.

Drive-in Theatres

6.2.2.7 The screen for a drive-in theatre shall be situated so that the projection surface is not visible from a public highway.

REGULATIONS IN RECREATIONAL COMMERCIAL (C7) ZONE

6.2.3 Any permitted use in any C7 Zone must comply with the following regulations:
