



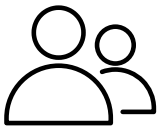

Kings County is the agricultural heart of Atlantic Canada, where productive land and a strong agri-food sector shape both the landscape and the economy.

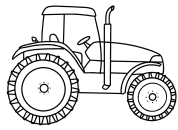
Defined by its orchards, vineyards, and proximity to the Bay of Fundy, the region continues to grow through strengths in manufacturing, defence, and innovation.

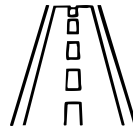
