Councillor Granger asked about Noise By-law enforcement throughout the County of Kings.

There was a discussion about the noise generated by ATVs and motorcycles.

Councillor Killam receives regular noise complaints regarding urban roosters.

Councillor Granger asked about the RCMPs views on body cams. Sgt. Kelly noted that the detachment here does not currently have body cams but are in favour of having this equipment. The RCMP vehicles are equipped with cameras but these do not always capture conversations. Councillor Killam noted that at the last Provincial Police Board meeting the consensus was that body cams would be a good thing to have.

Terry Brown noted that the human trafficking presentation shared with some members of this committee is in the process of being brought to Committee of the Whole or to Council so that all might be informed.
