Members of the Diversity Kings County Committee help determine where and how racism, discrimination and exclusion occur in the Municipality of the County of Kings. They also recommend policies, programs and practices to eliminate racism, discrimination and exclusion; monitor the effects of recommendations; and report on changes.

In addition to two (2) appointed Municipal Councillors and representatives from each of the three (3) Towns within the County, the committee is made up of six (6) citizens, representing Newcomers, African Nova Scotians, Indigenous Persons, young adults and citizens at large.

We are currently seeking applicants to fill the following vacant designated seats,

- One Indigenous Person, including Inuit, Métis, and First Nations individuals
- One young adult between the ages of 18 to 25, inclusive, at the time of appointment

Preference shall be given to those residing in the Municipality of the County of Kings.

Appointed citizens will serve a 2 year Term, unless Council directs otherwise.

Our commitment is to be a diverse and inclusive organization representative of the communities we serve. We encourage applications from Indigenous Peoples, persons of African Descent, Black Nova Scotians and other racially visible persons, persons living with disabilities, gender diverse persons, members of the S2LGBTQ+ Community, youth, and members of other historically under-represented communities. While we recognize there can be an inherent difficulty doing so, if you are a member of an equity-seeking group, you are encouraged to self-identify in your application. Applicants throughout the Municipality are encouraged to apply.

Appointed citizen member responsibilities include attending monthly meetings.
Honorariums are paid quarterly based on attendance.
