

# Fences Arbitration Committee

The Nominating Committee will recommend to Council the appointment of one (1) member to work alongside a member appointed through the Nova Scotia Federation of Agriculture. The member appointed will serve as Chair of the Committee.

The Fences Arbitration Committee is responsible to deal with disputes arising from Section 5 (1) of the Fences and Detention of Stray Livestock Act (R.S., c. 166). This Act requires owners of a livestock farm to build and maintain fences adequate to prevent the escape of livestock.

Members must be residents of the rural Municipality of the County of Kings and may hold office for a term not exceeding four years.

Appointed citizen members are required to attend monthly meetings and community functions. Honorariums are paid quarterly based on attendance.
