




# Why We're Here



- Ongoing conversation (with some stops and starts)
- Increased inquiries for development with urban characteristics within developed area:
  - Accessory dwellings
  - Multi-unit development
  - Increased permissions/Greater flexibility for commercial uses



# Why We're Here



- 2 requests for MPS amendments to enable residential development at a scale that is not currently enabled in Greenwich
- Municipal policy related to Municipal Planning Strategy amendment requests requires Staff review requests and prepare options to Council
- Options are reviewed against planning policies contained in the Municipal Planning Strategy (including a 'Do Nothing' option)
- Council determines direction
- Project must be taken through the normal process
- Staff are open to hearing all points of view no decisions have been made.
