### FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: IMPACT OF COVID-19 ON MUNICIPAL OPERATIONS

**KINGS COUNTY, NS:** In supportive response to the Declared State of Emergency made by Hon. Chuck Porter this afternoon, the Municipality of the County of Kings wishes to advise the public of the following:

- Inspections (fire & building) will now only occur to address life safety issues.
- Municipal Council is meeting remotely tomorrow morning to discuss how municipal business will be conducted over the coming weeks.
- Pursuant to the direction issued by the Province of Nova Scotia, all municipal parks/playgrounds (including the Harvest Moon Trail) and the Aylesford Lake Beach are now closed until further notice.
- Effectively immediately Kings Transit Authority has suspended service.
- All Nova Scotians have a moral and legal obligation to fully adhere to the advice of the Chief Medical Officer.

The Municipality **urges** residents and businesses to practice principles of **self-isolation** as much as possible and **social-distancing** always. The Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) Pandemic is a severe public health event and appropriate precautions must be taken seriously by everyone to ensure continued health and safety of our communities.
