



## **Aylesford Lake Beach Reopening on July 31, 2026**

### **July 31, 2026**

The swimming area at Aylesford Lake Public Beach is reopening at 1:00 p.m. on Friday July 31, 2026.

The swimming area was initially closed temporarily as a precautionary measure due to elevated bacteria counts in the lake on July 28. Water quality tests conducted on July 29 and July 30 confirmed it is safe to reopen the site for swimming and paddleboarding.

Daily lifeguarding services and Municipal paddleboard loans will resume Friday July 31 at 1:00 p.m.

Water quality is monitored regularly at Aylesford Lake Public Beach, and the Municipality consults with Nova Scotia Environment and Climate Change to determine when it is safe to reopen the beach after a closure.

The Municipality sincerely thanks everyone for their patience and cooperation during the recent closure of the swimming area.
