**KINGS COUNTY, NS** – There will be a Community Meeting about the recent spike in foul odours coming from the Regional Sewer Treatment Plant in New Minas on May 11.

Interested members of the public are encouraged to join us at the Louis Millett Community Complex at 7 p.m. in New Minas for a community conversation in Lynn Spencer Hall. The meeting will begin with the Municipality of the County of Kings sharing some background information in a presentation touching on the following topics:

- The Regional Sewer Treatment Plant
- Factors that contribute to foul odours
- What to expect during the upgrades taking place at the plant this spring and summer
- How the ongoing work fits in with a larger plan for long-term improvements

The public will have an opportunity to ask questions and share comments and concerns.

The Regional Sewer System services most residences and businesses between Greenwich and Coldbrook, and is funded under partnership agreements between the Municipality, Village of New Minas, Town of Kentville, and Pepsico.
