Jan. 9, 2024 – Municipal Council Meeting

Municipal Council passed motions giving direction on a variety of matters, including but not limited to:

- Give First Reading to, and approve a Public Hearing for, text amendments to the Land Use By-law to change the minimum lot area and lot frontage requirements for semi-detached dwellings within the Country Residential (A4) Zone
- Give First Reading to, and approve a Public Hearing for draft amendments to the Municipal Planning documents related to Development Incentives
- Proclaim February 2024 African Heritage Month in the Municipality of the County of Kings
- Adopt Policy EPW-04-016: Crosswalk Prioritization and Installation
- Approve \$6,400 in additional design and engineering costs for the Chapel Road Canning Infrastructure Upgrades Project
- Adopt changes to Policy FIN-05-007: Fire and Recreation Area Rates
- Give First Reading to changes to By-law 45: Street Lighting
- Direct the CAO to instruct staff to work with the RCMP to create policing-related content for municipal communications channels on a regular basis

Jan. 11, 2024 – Special Council Meeting

Municipal Council passed motions approving the following actions relating to four land-use planning matters discussed at the meeting:

- Remove 2176 Grand-Pré Road from the Grand-Pré Heritage Conservation District
- Rezone 5431 Highway 1 in Waterville from the Residential Mixed Density Zone (R3) to the Mixed Commercial Residential (C3) Zone
- Rezone a portion of 1291 Highway 201 and a portion of the adjoining vacant parcel (PIDs 55448005 and 55517080) in Greenwood from Rural Mixed Use (A2) to Rural Industrial (M3) Zone

- Give final consideration to entering into a development agreement to permit a comprehensive neighbourhood development on a vacant parcel of land on the west side of Collins Road in Port Williams
