



Municipality Accepting Applications for 2026 Community Grants Funding

The Municipality of the County of Kings is accepting applications for Community Grants that will provide funding support for a range of community-based projects, programs and events in 2026.

Community Grants are awarded annually to support the work of registered non-profit community organizations providing programs, infrastructure, services, and events in the Municipality.

Applications are open for the following funding opportunities:

Community Festivals and Special Events Grant – Apply by April 1, 2026

Park, Playground and Trail Grant – Apply by April 1, 2026

Kings Vision Grant – Apply by April 1, 2026

Community Hall Assistance Program Grant – Apply by May 1, 2026

Community Recreation Programming Assistance Grant – Apply by May 1, 2026

Graduation Event Assistance Grant – Apply by May 1, 2026

Councillor Grants to Organizations Grant – Apply by June 1, 2026

In January 2026, Municipal Council approved a new District Activity Fund that gives Members of Council opportunities to fund up to \$250 per organization once a year to eligible non-profits in support of local initiatives that are located within, or directly benefit, their district. The Municipality will have more information about how to apply for this funding following the approval of the 2026-27 Municipal Budget in the spring.
