Summer Recreation, Engineering, Environmental Services, Public Works and Customer Service positions are now posted on the Municipality's [website](#). Below is a list of summer job opportunities with the Municipality of the County of Kings:

**Recreation Summer Intern** Reporting to a Recreation Coordinator, the Recreation Intern will work collaboratively to plan the framework and support the delivery of youth day camps and mini camps (in various locations) as well as a variety of engaging community play activities for all age groups throughout Kings County during the summer. **Application deadline: Friday Feb. 27 at 4:30 p.m.**

**Recreation Assistants (2 positions)** Reporting to both the Recreation Coordinator and the Recreation Intern, the Summer Recreation Assistants will support and help deliver a variety of programs and activities at various locations across Kings County throughout the summer, serving youth as well as participants of all ages, including but not limited to: Pop up plays, Camps including Day Camps, Mini-Camps, Sport Camps, and Paddle Camps, "Learn To" and "Try It" opportunities, and Party in the Park. **Application deadline: Feb. 27 at 4:30 p.m.**

**Program Accessibility and Inclusion Facilitator** The Program Accessibility and Inclusion Facilitator will be responsible for ensuring that all recreational programs and activities are accessible and inclusive for participants of all abilities. In addition to facilitating youth camps, pop-up plays, crafts, and other recreational activities, the facilitator will assess, plan, and adapt programs to meet the needs of individuals with disabilities or other diverse requirements. The facilitator will promote an inclusive environment where all participants feel welcomed and supported, ensuring that accommodations are provided as needed to ensure full participation. They will also communicate with parents/guardians regarding any accommodations or adjustments required for their children to fully engage in the programs. The role will also include collaborating with the Municipality's recreation staff to ensure all activities and facilities comply with accessibility best practices. **Application deadline: Feb. 27 at 4:30 p.m.**

**Community Play Specialist – Team Lead** Reporting to both a Recreation Coordinator and the Recreation Intern, the Community Play Specialist Team Lead will work collaboratively to plan and deliver youth day camps and mini camps in various locations throughout July and August. In addition to leading these camps, they will spearhead engaging community play activities for all ages throughout Kings County during the summer months. Responsibilities of the Lead include

overseeing two Play Specialists and ensuring the safety of participants, interacting with parents/guardians, and collaborating with the Municipality's recreation staff. **Application deadline: Feb. 27 at 4:30 p.m.**

**Community Play Specialists (2 positions)** Working with a Team Lead, the Community Play Specialists will deliver full day and mini camps to youth in various locations across Kings County throughout July and August. Additionally, Community Play Specialists will be hands-on in hosting pop-up plays, pop-up crafts, and other exciting activities for all ages. They will be responsible for the safety of the participants and will frequently interact with parents/guardians and the Municipality's recreation staff. **Application deadline: Feb. 27 at 4:30 p.m.**

**Paddling Program Team Lead** The Paddling Program Team Lead will plan and collaboratively work with the Paddling Program staff to deliver three, 3-day Paddle camps. These camps will focus on fun and include instructing participants (aged 8-13) on basic kayaking skills, stroke development, basic SUP use, and boating/water safety. Responsibilities of the Lead include overseeing Summer Paddle Staff and ensuring the safety of participants, interacting with parents/guardians, and collaborating with the Municipality's recreation staff. The Paddle Program Team Lead will also be responsible for the public Kayak/Paddle Board loan program. **Application deadline: Feb. 27 at 4:30 p.m.**

**Paddling Program Position – (2 positions)** Working with a Team Lead, paddling staff will collaboratively work to deliver three, 3-day Kayak camps. These camps will focus on fun and include instructing participants (aged 8-13) on basic kayaking skills, stroke development, basic SUP use, boating/water safety, and engaging onshore activities. Paddling staff are responsible for ensuring the safety of participants, interacting with parents/guardians, and collaborating with the Municipality's recreation staff. Summer paddling staff will also be responsible for the public Kayak/Paddle Board loan program. **Application deadline: Feb. 27 at 4:30 p.m.**

**Engineering Services Summer Student Position** This position will offer the successful candidate an opportunity to improve their skills and gain experience working in a municipal environment. By the end of the work term and under the supervision of the professional engineers, the student will have a working knowledge of Municipal Engineering Services and familiarity with the municipal water and wastewater systems, storm, and roads. **Application deadline: Feb. 20 at 4:30 p.m.**

**Climate Change & Environmental Services Summer Student** The primary responsibilities will involve gathering and analyzing data pertinent to various Water Treatment and Wastewater Treatment Facilities. Additionally, the successful candidate will assist our Climate Change staff with the coordination and planning of future capital projects. This hands-on role presents an unparalleled opportunity to actively contribute to environmental compliance initiatives while gaining invaluable practical experience in the field. **Application deadline: Feb. 27 at 4:30 p.m.**

**General Maintenance Worker Summer Student Position** The General Maintenance Worker will take direction from the Manager of Public Works and must have experience operating one or more of the following pieces of equipment: lawn tractors, compact tractors, farm tractors, bush hogs, clearing saws, ground compaction equipment, and water pumps. Strong communication and time management skills are necessary. Safety is a top priority. General job duties include: maintenance of existing green spaces at Municipal water/wastewater treatment and related facilities (including

mowing, brush cutting / removal, fertilizing, new planting, and restoration), general project management tasks (i.e., maintenance schedule updates), general road maintenance, such as line painting and signage installation, fire hydrant painting and related greenspace maintenance. The successful candidate will also assist Engineering & Public Works Skilled Labourer to complete greenspace maintenance and other basic housekeeping tasks as needed. Other related duties as assigned. **Application deadline: Feb. 27 at 4:30 p.m.**

**Customer Service - Summer Intern** Reporting to the Manager of Inspections and Enforcement the Customer Service Summer Intern will: provide prompt and exceptional customer service for all municipal departments by being the first point of contact for the public, answer all public inquiries and engage with customers to ensure proper redirection when required, prepare cash drawer, process counter receipts, input payments, balance cash and complete bank deposits for approval, respond to property tax inquiries, process building permit applications, issue dog tags, schedule fire and building inspections, provide administrative support including filing, sorting and distributing all incoming mail and preparing outgoing mail, scanning documents, file management and other general administrative duties, and complete other duties as assigned. **Application deadline: Feb. 27 at 4:30 p.m.**

**Inclusive Communities Intern** The Inclusive Communities Intern reports to the Manager of Community Development, works closely with the Diversity Specialists and is responsible for contributing to our organization in the areas of diversity, equity, inclusion, justice and belonging.
