

SPECIAL ELECTION IN DISTRICT 8 (NEW MINAS & GREENWICH)

E-VOTING AVAILABLE JUNE 17 - 24, 2023

Following the resignation of the Councillor for District 8 (New Minas and Greenwich), a Special Election will be held on Saturday, June 24, 2023. Voters in District 8 will have the option to **vote electronically (on the internet or by telephone) 24 hours per day**



during the period of Saturday, June 17 beginning at 12:00 noon and ending at the closing of the polls on June 24 at 7:00pm. There will be no paper balloting, but assistance will be made available in-person or by phone for anyone having issues with electronic voting.

Eligible voters will receive an instruction letter in the mail. If you have not received a letter by June 15, 2023, please contact the Returning Officer at 902-690-VOTE or <u>election@countyofkings.ca</u>.

Qualifications to Vote:

In order to be eligible to vote:

- you must be 18 years or older on the first advance polling day (June 17)
- you must be a Canadian citizen on the first advance polling day (June 17)
- you must have been ordinarily resident in Nova Scotia for at least six months immediately preceding the first advance polling day
- you must be a resident of District 8 in the Municipality of the County of Kings since immediately before the first advance polling day (June 17)

Are you interested in running for Council in District 8? Qualifications to Run for Council:

- You must be 18 years of age at the time of nomination
- You must be a Canadian citizen
- You must have been ordinarily resident in the Municipality of the County of Kings for 6 months preceding nomination day (May 30), and continue to do so
- You must have obtained a certificate that, as of nomination day, the charges that are liens on your property and the taxes due to the Municipality have been fully paid or all instalments or interim payments that are due as of nomination day have been paid
- You are not disqualified under the *Municipal Elections Act*

Nomination papers may be submitted between 9:00am and 5:00pm on Nomination Day, Tuesday, May 30, 2023, or by appointment during office hours during the 5 business days preceding Nomination Day.
