## **A Message from Mayor Peter Muttart: \$600,000 in Kings Vision Grants Awarded**

The Municipality of the County of Kings is proud to financially assist our citizens who plan tangible projects that show vision. Each year of our 2020-2024 term, your Council set aside \$600,000 and invited our community to apply for grants from that fund.

We always receive more applications than we can assist – but what a blessing it is that we have so many inspiring projects from which to choose!

This year, applications have closed, and twenty-four non-profit organizations will directly benefit from Kings Vision Grant applications that were approved by Municipal Council on May 21.

Kings Vision Grants are awarded annually in support of non-profit organizations undertaking projects that clearly align with at least one of the Key Strategic Priorities outlined in the Municipality's [Strategic Plan](#): Strong Communities, Environmental Stewardship, Economic Development, Good Governance, and Financial Sustainability.
