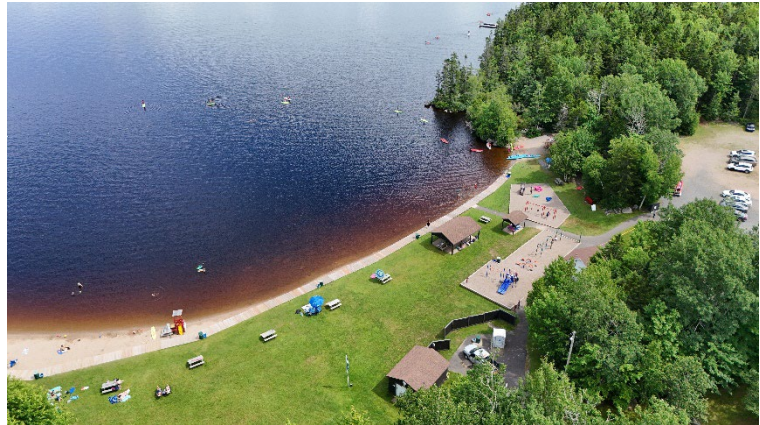

Aylesford Lake Public Beach Open for 2026 Season

KINGS COUNTY, N.S. – Aylesford Lake Public Beach will soon be open evenings and weekends.

The popular recreation destination owned and operated by the Municipality of the County of Kings opened for daytime use from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday to Friday on June 1. As of June 13, the Public Beach will be open from 10 a.m. to 8 p.m. daily, with lifeguards on site from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. every day starting June 14.



Aylesford Lake Public Beach is located at 580 North River Road.

The [Municipality's free kayak and paddleboard loan program](#) for paddlers of all skill levels will run until **Aug. 28**. Walk-up loans begin July 1, and online reservations open July 3.

- The Municipality makes the paddling equipment available at no cost.
- 50-minute loan sessions beginning on the hour will run from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. seven days a week on a first-come, first-served basis.

Aylesford Lake Public Beach has an inclusive indoor washroom and changing facility, accessible parking lot, boardwalk and gazebo, sheltered playground, paved pathways to key service areas, accessible beach and water access, and a playbox with yard games and beach toys for beachgoers to borrow.
