Municipality Addressing Odour at Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant in New Minas

June 18, 2026

The Municipality of the County of Kings is actively working to address a recent increase in odour at the Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant in New Minas as soon as possible.

A preliminary investigation determined that warmer temperatures are impacting the dissolved oxygen levels in the treatment lagoons.

Work is underway to add more oxygen-boosting agents to the biological system to correct the upset contributing to problematic odours.

Staff are closely monitoring the results of corrective actions taken to address the odour. The top priority is to reduce the severity and duration of odours that impact nearby communities as quickly as possible.

The Regional Sewer System services most residences and businesses between Greenwich and Coldbrook and is funded under partnership agreements between the Municipality, Village of New Minas, Town of Kentville, and PepsiCo.
