Public Advisory: Aylesford Lake Beach

KINGS COUNTY, NS – The Municipality of the County of Kings contacted the provincial Department of Environment and Climate Change following a report of a possible blue-green algae sighting at Aylesford Lake Beach in June.

- The Department of Environment advised that there has not been a confirmed blue-green algae bloom identified through testing or inspection.
- The report of a possible blue-green algae bloom sighting, however, will remain on the [provincial reporting website](#) for the rest of the summer.

Municipal staff and lifeguards working at Aylesford Lake Public Beach for the summer season are all aware of the importance of watching for blue-green algae, and the procedure to follow if there is a potential sighting.

A public advisory will be issued if there is a need for precautionary measures at Aylesford Lake Public Beach.
