Aylesford Lake Beach Closed for Swimming Until Further Notice

June 30, 2026

Aylesford Lake Public Beach is closed for swimming and paddle boarding until further notice due to elevated bacterial levels in recent water sampling results.

Water closures are necessary when bacteria levels are too high. This decision is based on criteria listed in the “[Guidelines for Canadian Recreational Water Quality](#).”

The swimming area is closed to the public for the purpose of swimming and paddle boarding. Kayaking is still allowed. All other land-based amenities at the Public Beach, including the playground and gathering areas, are still open for use.

The swimming area will remain closed while sampling continues into Wednesday and Thursday. The Municipality will post an update regarding the status of the closure on Friday, July 3.

The swimming area will be reopened when test results confirm that bacterial levels are acceptable. Updates will be shared at www.countyofkings.ca and on the Municipality’s [Facebook](#) and X (formerly [Twitter](#)) pages.
