



Aylesford Lake Beach Closed for Swimming Until Further Notice

July 28, 2026

Aylesford Lake Public Beach is closed for swimming and paddleboarding until further notice due to elevated bacterial levels in recent water sampling results.

Water-related closures are necessary when bacteria levels are too high. This decision is based on criteria listed in the "[Guidelines for Canadian Recreational Water Quality](#)."

The swimming area will be reopened when test results confirm that bacterial levels are acceptable. The Municipality will post an update regarding the status of the closure on Thursday, July 30.

Information regarding changes to paddle camp programming will be circulated to registered participants and their caregivers.
