Regional Treatment Plant Update

August 27, 2021

Dear Residents,

The desludging operations at the Regional Sewer Treatment Plant in New Minas are complete. The work planned for the primary lagoon wrapped up ahead of schedule, making it possible for sludge removal operations to temporarily shift to a second lagoon.

- Approximately 6,950 tonnes of processed, dewatered sludge was removed from the lagoons and transported to approved disposal facilities in New Brunswick and Nova Scotia.
- Desludging operations concluded on schedule - and on budget - Aug. 12.
- The required clean-up work at the Regional Treatment Plant and temporary loading sites in the Jones Road gravel pit area concluded on Aug. 23.
- The temporary storage pad, weigh scale and related items have been removed as part of the site restoration process.
- Preliminary planning is underway to prepare for future projects related to odour reduction and aeration system upgrades in Lagoons 1 and 2.

The Municipality of the County of Kings would like to thank residents of New Minas and the surrounding areas, the business community and frequent visitors of the Harvest Moon Trail for their patience.

The desludging work is part of a multiple phase, multimillion-dollar plan that will improve performance and efficiency at the Regional Sewer Treatment Plant serving Coldbrook to Greenwich.
