



Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant Lagoon 2 Desludging Begins Sept. 15

There will be an increase in heavy truck traffic near the Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant in New Minas in September and October.

The planned desludging of Lagoon 2 is scheduled to start on Sept. 15. Trucks will be travelling to and from the Treatment Plant via Jones Road seven days a week, day and night, for two to three weeks.

It is possible there will be temporary periods of odour and construction noise during the desludging process. The Municipality apologizes for any inconvenience this may cause.

Sludge removal is an important step toward improving Plant performance and reducing the likelihood of problematic odours in the future.

The Municipality and its funding partners - the Town of Kentville, Village of New Minas, and Pepsico – are committed to a multi-year plan for odour management improvements and upgrades at the Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant.
