- The official list of candidates will be posted on the Municipality's website by 4:30 p.m. on Sept. 11. You'll find a list of candidates running for Mayor and District Councillor at www.countyofkings.ca/election.
- Visit the [election website](#) or contact the [Election Office](#) before October to read candidate profiles, "Find Your District" and confirm that you're on the Voters' List.
- Annapolis Valley Chamber of Commerce is hosting a Mayoral Candidates' Forum on Sept. 24 at 6:30 p.m. in the Coldbrook Lions Hall. A moderator will ask questions submitted by the public. For more info, visit <https://annapolisvalleychamber.ca/event/kings-county-mayoral-forum/>.
- Voter Information Letters with voting instructions will be mailed in late September. Check the mail and let us know if you did not receive yours by Oct. 4. Call 902-690-8683 or email election@countyofkings.ca.
