Spotlight on Services: Connected Kings High-speed Internet Expansion

KINGS COUNTY, N.S. – A new 80-kilometre fibre optic network jointly funded by the Municipality and federal government’s Connect to Innovate Program is now operational.

- The \$3.4 million Connected Kings project was announced in 2018, and construction was completed in July 2022.
- The fibre-optic transport network enabled Cross Country TV to expand its coverage area and provide high-speed internet services in the communities of Woodville, Black Rock, Canada Creek and North Grand-Pré.
- More than 100 homes are now connected to the new network.

The Municipality’s 2022-23 capital budget includes additional funds that are being used to investigate the possibility of extending the fibre optic network to make it available to more residents.
