Spotlight on Services: Greenwood Water Utility

KINGS COUNTY, N.S. – In addition to maintaining regular operations at the Greenwood Water Utility, the Municipality is planning for the future and investing in key capital upgrades, including enhancements to the water distribution system, water treatment system, storage towers and production wells.

- The Greenwood Water Utility supplies water to approximately 687 residential dwellings and 45 commercial properties.
- Approximately 900 cubic metres (m³) or 900,000 litres (L) of water is treated at the Greenwood Water Treatment Plant on a daily basis in the late fall and winter months, compared to approximately 1,200 m³ (1,200,000 L) in the warmer months.
- Two 65-foot-tall water towers (each with a storage capacity of 350,000 US gallons, or 1.3 million litres) were refurbished in 2021 and 2022, and an expansion of the UV treatment system is currently underway and nearing completion.
- Two new water wells slated for construction in 2023 will be connected to the transmission network to accommodate future growth in the community.
- Treatment Plant Operator Larry Fredericks received an Excellence in Public Service Award and a Long Service Award last December recognizing his 20 years with the Municipality of the County of Kings.
