The recipient of the Volunteer of the Year Award will also be invited to attend the annual Provincial Volunteer Awards as the Municipality's representative and receive the provincial award.

Ted Meldrum Award: Ted Meldrum, a former employee of the Municipality, was an active volunteer – particularly in the field of recreation. In memory of Ted Meldrum, this award honours one individual who demonstrates an enthusiasm for community through volunteerism.
