Motions from the Jan. 6 Municipal Council meeting

Council passed motions approving the following actions:

- Give Second Reading to the application to rezone 1184 Parkway Drive in Port Williams from the General Commercial (C1) Zone to the Light Industrial Commercial (M1) Zone.
- Give Second Reading to the application to rezone 1025 Sherman Belcher Road in Centreville from the Residential One Unit (R1) Zone to the Residential Mixed Density (R3) Zone.
- Refer the application to amend the text of the Land Use By-Law to add Carwash Facilities to the list of permitted uses in the Rural Commercial (C4) Zone back to staff to draft conditions related to the development of Carwash Facilities in the C4 Zone to be presented to Council for First Reading at a future date.
- Adopt Policy FIN-05-029: District Activity Funds as attached to the Jan. 6, 2026, agenda and that the Policy is reviewed after one year.

- Proclaim February 2026 as “African Heritage Month” in the Municipality of the County of Kings.
