Motions from the July 22 Special Council meeting

Council passed motions approving the following actions:

- Provide seven days' notice to adopt Policy HR-06-024: Pensions.
- Approve the proposed plan for hosting District meetings in 2025-26.
- Proclaim August 1 as Emancipation Day in the Municipality of the County of Kings.
- Proclaim August 15 as National Acadian Day in the Municipality of the County of Kings.
- Provide seven days' notice to adopt Policy ADMIN-01-025: Land Acknowledgement.
- Approve the Housing Accelerator Fund Disbursement and Advocacy Program.
- Approve the Municipality of the County of Kings' proportional share of the guarantee associated with the Valley Region Solid Waste-Resource Management Authority's Debenture.

Motions from the July 8 Municipal Council meeting

Council passed motions approving the following actions:

- Give Second Reading to the application to rezone 836 Main Street in Kingston from the General Commercial (C1) Zone to the Mixed Commercial Residential (C3) Zone.
- Give First Reading to and hold a Public Hearing regarding changes to the text of the Land
 Use By-law to enable two secondary suites within a one-unit dwelling in the Residential
 One Unit (R1) Zone and associated amendments.
- Give Initial Consideration to, and hold a Public Hearing regarding, entering into a Development Agreement to legalize and permit the expansion of a Professional Trade on the property located at 808 Main Street in Kingston.
- Change Policy COMM-02-003: Proclamations.

- Change Policy FIN-05-006: Procurement.
- Repeal Policy EPW-04-010: Engineering Services Procurement.
- Receive the Regional Sewer Update presentation provided on July 8, 2025, for information.
- Give Second Reading to change the Private Road Maintenance & Improvement Charge By-law.
- Approve the levying, collection and remittance of the Area Rates as shown in the July 8, 2025, Request for Decision.
- Reconsider the motion related to Council and Committee of the Whole meetings in August 2025 that failed at the June 3, 2025, Council meeting.
- That Municipal Council and Committee of the Whole not meet in August 2025 unless required for urgent and pressing matters.
