Motions from the July 21 Special Council meeting

Council passed motions approving the following actions:

- Proclaim Aug. 1, 2026, as Emancipation Day across the Municipality of the County of Kings.
- Proclaim Aug. 15, 2026, as National Acadian Day across the Municipality of the County of Kings.
- Provide seven days' notice, per s.48(1) *Municipal Government Act*, to rename and amend Policy EPW-04-015: Active Transportation Project Prioritization to Policy EPW-04-015: Active Transportation Network Project Prioritization.
- Give first reading to change By-law 74, the Treasurer By-law.
- Give first reading to change By-law 90, the Vendors By-law.

Motions from the July 7 Municipal Council meeting

Council passed motions approving the following actions:

- Give First Reading to, and hold a Public Hearing regarding, the application to rezone two vacant parcels located on Mayhew Drive (PIDs 55552772 and 55552780) in Greenwood from the Residential One Unit (R1) Zone to the Residential One and Two Unit (R2) Zone to permit the development of semi-detached dwellings.
- Proclaim Oct. 10, 2026, to be National Dental Care Day in the Municipality of the County of Kings.

- Proclaim Oct. 15, 2026, to be Pregnancy and Infant Loss Awareness Day in the Municipality of the County of Kings.
- Approve the 2026-27 Kings Vision Grant allocations for the existing multi-year applications as described in Appendix A attached to the July 7, 2026, Request for Decision for a total of \$162,570.
- Approve the 2026-27 Kings Vision Grant allocations for the new application requests as described in Appendix B attached to the July 7, 2026, Request for Decision for a total of \$437,430.
- Approve an additional budget of \$570,000 for Capital Project 08-3409 – Municipal STP Infrastructure Renewal, to be financed through the use of long-term debt previously assigned to other wastewater treatment plant upgrade projects.
- Receive the Update on Regional Sewer presentation as provided on July 7, 2026, for information.
- Give second reading to change By-law 93, the Private Road Maintenance & Improvement Charge By-law.
- Give second reading to change By-law 98, the Wastewater Sewer By-law.
