Motions from the June 16 Special Council meeting

Council passed motions approving the following actions:

- Approve the Capital Budget of the Hantsport Volunteer Fire Department for the 2026/27 budget year.
- Approve the levying, collection and remittance of the Area Rates as shown in Appendix A: Area Rates 2026/27 and approve the 4% administration fee charged against the Area Rates collected in Appendix B: Area Rates for Fire Commissions 2026/27, as attached to the June 16, 2026, Request for Decision.
- Direct the Chief Administrative Officer to enter into a Funding Agreement with the Trans County Transportation Society as presented in the June 16, 2026, Request for Decision.

Motions from the June 2 Municipal Council meeting

Council passed motions approving the following actions:

- Support the application by Canacre Ltd./Bell Mobility to site a 40-metre telecommunications tower on a leased portion of 211 Topline Boulevard in Canaan.
- Give Final Consideration regarding entering into a development agreement to convert an existing building into a one-unit dwelling at 1138 West Halls Harbour Road in Halls Harbour.
- Approve the discharge of the Development Agreement registered May 7, 2007, between M.I.R 1 Developments Inc. and the Municipality for 9693 Commercial Street in New Minas and 9701 Commercial Street in New Minas.
- Order that within 30 days of the date of the Order the owner of PIDs 55492326, 55058283 and 55492334 demolish the dwelling and accessory building located at 491 Aldershot Road.

- Proclaim June 5, 2026, to be “Cole Wittenberg Day” in the Municipality of the County of Kings.
- Authorize the Mayor to send a letter to Canadian Air Division Headquarters to express support of a flyby by Canadian Armed Forces aircraft as low as 500 feet at the East Dalhousie Day event on Aug. 29, 2026
- Change Policy FIN-05-026: Tax Exemption for Non-Profit Organizations, as attached to the June 2, 2026, agenda.
- Give First Reading to change the Private Road Maintenance & Improvement Charge By-law, By-law 93.
