On July 1, 12-year-old Landyn Toney, a young man whose community is Annapolis Valley First Nations, near Cambridge, began a 200-kilometre trek from Bible Hill, intending to arrive in his home community of AVFN today.

Landyn's goal is to raise awareness of the truth, cruelty and sadness of the origin, intent and impact of residential schools on generations of the Indigenous population – on Landyn's people.

We say to Landyn: "On behalf of the Council and citizens of the Municipality of the County of Kings: We see you. We hear you. We understand. We support you and the Nation you represent. We are humbled by your actions. As a Council and as a people, we will continue, actively, to pursue the objectives of Truth and Reconciliation.
