

November 2025 Fast Fasts from Council Chambers

Motions from the Nov. 3 Council meeting:

Council passed motions approving the following actions:

- Give Second Reading to changes to the text of the Land Use By-law to clarify regulations related to accessory commercial patio areas as described in Appendix A of the report dated Sept. 9, 2025.
- Advise that the refusal of the application to enter into a Development Agreement to permit a Tourist Commercial Use at PID 55224067 Greenfield Road in Gaspereau was due to incompatibility with surrounding community, potential high impact of use of agricultural land, and community opposition.
- Give Second Reading to the application to rezone 2716 Highway 1 in Aylesford from the Central Business (C2) Zone to the Mixed Commercial Residential (C3) Zone.
- Give Second Reading to the application to rezone 8877 Commercial Street in New Minas from the General Commercial (C1) Zone to the Mixed Commercial Residential (C3) Zone.
- Give First Reading to, and hold a Public Hearing regarding, the adoption of By-law 114: Subdivision By-law and the 2025 Municipal Service Systems Specifications Manual.
- Direct the CAO to oversee the development of a Municipal Well Upgrade Program
 designed to support homeowners through low interest loans in the development of a
 new well.
- Give Second Reading to the Deed Transfer Tax By-law, By-law 113.
- Adopt Policy FIN-05-029: Deed Transfer Tax Reserve.
- Request the Minister of Municipal Affairs to agree that the Registrar of Deeds is to be the Municipality's agent and collector of the Deed Transfer Tax for the Municipality.

- Set the term of office for the Deputy Mayor for one year.
- Give First Reading to the By-law Respecting Charges for the Improvement of Water Supply, By-law 115.
- Approve the Collective Agreement with the Canadian Union of Public Employees Local 2618, for the period from November 1, 2024, to Oct. 31, 2027.
