Motions from the Sept. 16 Special Council meeting

Council passed motions approving the following actions:

- Direct the Chief Administrative Officer to begin the process of amending the Municipal Planning Strategy and Land Use By-law to permit the development of accessory dwellings in rural areas.
- Ask the CAO to return with a report regarding if and how the Municipality might be able to participate in the Valley Wildcats programs.

Motions from the Sept. 2 Municipal Council meeting

Council passed motions approving the following actions:

- Give Second Reading to the amendments to the text of the Land Use By-law to enable two secondary suites within a one-unit dwelling in the Residential One Unit (R1) Zone and associated amendments as described in Appendix A of the report dated June 10, 2025.
- Give Final Consideration to entering into a Development Agreement to legalize and permit the expansion of a Professional Trade on the property located at 808 Main Street in Kingston.
- Adopt Policy HR-06-024: Pensions as attached to the Sept. 2, 2025, Council agenda.
- Adopt Policy ADMIN-01-025: Land Acknowledgement as attached to the Sept. 2 Council agenda.
- Proclaim Oct. 10, 2025, to be “National Dental Care Day” in the Municipality of the County of Kings.

- Receive the Regional Sewer Update Briefing as attached to the Sept. 2 Council agenda for information.
- Instruct the CAO to return to Municipal Council Oct. 7 with a draft Deed Transfer Tax By-law and an accompanying Deed Transfer Tax Reserve Policy.
