Motions from the Sept. 15 Special Council meeting

Council passed motions approving the following actions:

- Give seven days' notice, per s. 48(1) *Municipal Government Act*, to adopt Policy ADMIN-01-026: RCAF Flyby Authorization.
- Give First Reading to amend By-law 102: Committees Governance to delete the reference to "Sandy Court Source Water Protection Committee" from Schedule A (Committees of Council).
- Repeal the Terms of Reference for the Sandy Court Source Water Protection Committee.
- Give seven days' notice, per s. 48(1) *Municipal Government Act*, to repeal Policy EPW-04-009: Greenwood Water Utility Source Water Protection Committee.
- Adopt the new Terms of Reference for the Greenwood Water Utility Source Water Protection Committee, as attached to the Sept. 15, 2026 Request for Decision, concurrent to the amendment to By-law 102, repeal of Sandy Court Terms of Reference, and repeal of Policy EPW-04-009.
- Approve the Tidal Transit Authority Municipal Partner Guarantee Resolution as detailed in the Request for Decision dated Sept. 15, 2026, in the amount of \$4,713,821.

Motions from the Sept. 1 Municipal Council meeting

Council passed motions approving the following actions:

- Give Second Reading to the application to rezone two vacant parcels located on Mayhew Drive (PIDs 55552772 and 55552780) in Greenwood from the Residential One Unit (R1) Zone to the Residential One and Two Unit (R2) Zone to permit the development of semi-detached dwellings.
- Give First Reading to and hold a Public Hearing regarding the application to rezone a vacant property located on Commercial Street (PID 55210884) in New Minas from the Residential Mixed Density (R3) Zone to the Residential Multi-unit (R4) Zone.
- Give First Reading to and hold a Public Hearing regarding the application to rezone the portion of 130 Cornwallis Ave in New Minas zoned Residential Multi-unit (R4) to the Institutional (I1) Zone.
- Proclaim Sept. 30, 2026, as the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation and Oct. 1, 2026, as Treaty Day in the Municipality of the County of Kings.
- Proclaim October 2026 as Mi'kmaw History Month in the Municipality of the County of Kings.
- Authorize the Municipality of the County of Kings to become a signatory to the 2026 Reciprocal Agreement for the Corridor of Incubators of the International Network of Michelin Cities.
- Authorize the Mayor and CAO make a change to the Feb. 25, 2026, Regional Recreation Facility Memorandum of Understanding that enables the current Deputy Mayors of the Participating Municipal Units continued participation on the related Steering Committee in the event they no longer hold the office of Deputy Mayor but retain the office of a municipal Councillor on their respective municipal council.
- Authorize the Mayor and CAO to execute Cost Share Agreement No. 2026-007 with the Nova Scotia Department of Public Works.
- Rename and change Policy EPW-04-015: Active Transportation Project Prioritization to Policy EPW-04-015: Active Transportation Network Project Prioritization.
- Provide seven days' notice, per s.48(1) *Municipal Government Act*, to repeal Policy EPW-04-014: Sidewalk Construction Project Prioritization.
