

Kayak and Stand-Up Paddleboard Loans at Aylesford Lake Public Beach

How do I pre-book a boat?

Visit www.countyofkings.ca/registration and create a free account to book!

What do you have available?

We have a fleet of single kayaks, double kayaks, adult stand-up paddleboards and youth stand-up paddleboards.

What days and times do you have available?

We are offering loans 7 days a week from July 1-August 28th. Pre-booking availability varies, so please refer to the website. July 1- walk-ins only, pre-booking starts July 3, 2026. Loan times are available at 10:00am, 11:00am, 12:00pm, 1:00pm, 2:00pm, 3:00pm, and 4:00pm, with each loan lasting 50 minutes.

Can I book a group loan under my name?

Each person in your group needs their own Univerus Rec account to reserve or be associated with an account as a family member. Double kayaks only require one person to book.

How close to my preferred time can I book?

Bookings must be made 12 hours in advance. Within 12 hours walk-up loans can be made on-site, based on availability.

Can I book more than one time slot per day?

Please only book 1-time slot per day per person. If more than 1-time slot is booked per day, staff may contact you to adjust your booking.

What's included with the loan?

Lif jackets, paddles and boat safety kits are included in the loan. You may opt to bring your own Canadian Approved lifejacket or PFD, but staff has the right to refuse any outside lifejackets.

What are the ages? Can my child or youth go alone?

Children under the age of 8 must be accompanied by an adult in the boat. Youth under the age of 15 must be accompanied by a person responsible for their care and over the age of 18 on the water.

I need support, who can I call?

During July and August, please call 902-690-2452. Paddle staff may be assisting with loans at the time of your call, so please leave a voicemail and they will return your call as soon as they are available. You may also email paddleloans@countyofkings.ca.

HOW OLD DO I HAVE TO BE TO BORROW A KAYAK OR PADDLEBOARD

Ages 0-7: permitted to be in the boat with an adult (double kayak or sit in the cockpit or on the board with an adult).

Ages 8-14: Youth under the age of 15 must be accompanied by a person responsible for their care and over the age of 18 on the water.

Ages 15+: Permitted to be in their own boat. *We strongly encourage people to never paddle alone.*
