Re: Proposed Amendments to the *Nova Scotia Building Code Regulations*

I am writing to give you formal notice of proposed amendments to the *Nova Scotia Building Code Regulations* pursuant to the *Building Code Act*, R.S. N.S. 1989, Chapter 46.

The proposed amendments will reformat the regulation into the standard format and wording required of all regulations in the province. This is a requirement of the Registrar of Regulations and without this reformatting of the regulation, no future amendments will be permitted to be made to the regulation. It is anticipated that these regulations will come into effect on or about October 1, 2022.

The Office of the Fire Marshal is now engaging in a minimum 45-day public notice period beginning March 14, 2022 and finishing on April 29, 2022.


