Duties

The Municipality is seeking a student or recent graduate with an ESRI ArcGIS skill set, a high attention to detail, and who enjoys working outdoors. The ideal candidate would also have training and experience in topographic surveying, either with GPS or line-of-sight survey equipment. Working with ESRI ArcGIS and Leica technologies, the GIS Technician's duties will primarily support the following initiatives:

- Digitization of CAD files, as-built documentation and aerial imagery to ArcGIS Enterprise;
- Producing maps related to digitized data;
- Survey of Municipal and Village-related infrastructure assets, including, but not limited to, water and wastewater assets, and digitization to ArcGIS Enterprise;
- Planning, coordination of volunteers, water sample and data management, and field work related to the Municipality's Lake Monitoring Program;
- Other duties as required.

In past summers, GIS and Survey students have had the opportunity to work on a number of projects not listed in their official duties. These projects have included work on Municipal Heritage Properties, Community Wellhead Protection, Pollution Abatement and special mapping projects for Community groups i.e. watershed and water sampling sites for The Friends of the Cornwallis River Society and trails mapping for local trail societies.

- Demonstrated knowledge and competency using ESRI ArcGIS Pro;
- Experience with Microsoft Word, Excel and PowerPoint;
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team;
- Strong verbal and written communication skills.

Desired Competencies
