Strong communication and time management skills are necessary. Safety is a top priority.

General job duties will be as follows:

- Maintenance of existing green spaces at Municipal water/wastewater treatment and related facilities including mowing, brush cutting / removal, fertilizing, new planting, and restoration of existing, general project management tasks (i.e., maintenance schedule updates), etc.
- General road maintenance such as line painting and signage installation.
- Fire hydrant painting and related greenspace maintenance.
- Assist Engineering & Public Works Skilled Labourer to complete greenspace maintenance and other basic housekeeping tasks as needed.
- Other related duties as assigned.

Job requirements for this position are as follows:

- Enrolled in a community college or university program.
- Strong work ethic and ability to work in a team environment.
- Has experience working in a safety sensitive position.
- The successful applicant will need their own safety boots and a valid driver's license.
- Applicable safety training will be provided.
