Community Play Specialists Team Lead: Reporting to both a Recreation Coordinator and the Recreation Intern, the Community Play Specialist Team Lead will work collaboratively to plan and deliver youth day camps and mini camps in various locations throughout July & August. In addition to leading these camps, they will spearhead engaging community play activities for all ages throughout Kings County during the summer months. Responsibilities of the Lead include overseeing two Play Specialists and ensuring the safety of participants, interacting with parents/guardians, and collaborating with the Municipality's recreation staff.

The ideal Play Specialist Team Lead will be a great communicator who is also an outgoing, patient, compassionate and creative high school or post-secondary student. Having prior experience in a leadership role working with youth is considered an asset.
