

Skilled Labourer - Seasonal

We are looking for a dynamic, values-based contributor to support our vision of a community of communities where all people belong, to join our fantastic team through the role of ***Seasonal Summer Labourer***. We value integrity, respect, excellence, transparency, innovation, diversity and sustainability in all that we do, and need a team builder who does too!

Our goal is to be a diverse and inclusive workforce representative of the communities we serve at all job levels. Our priority for this posting is applications from persons identifying as Indigenous People, Persons of African Descent, Black/African Nova Scotians and other Racially Visible Persons, Persons Living with Disabilities, Gender Diverse Persons and members of other historically excluded communities. While we recognize the inherent difficulty of doing so, if you are a member of an equity-seeking group, you are encouraged to self-identify in your cover letter or your resume.

Reporting to the Manager of Engineering Services, the Seasonal Skilled Labourer role is to maintain the Aylesford Lake Municipal Beach and other Municipal properties.

The successful candidate will provide assistance performing the following duties:

- On-site management of the Municipal Beach at Aylesford Lake including the Public Boat Launch;
- Maintenance of Silver Lake and Loon Lake public access, McMaster Mill Park, Black River Boat Launch and other municipal facilities;
- Will be employed in the capacity of caretakers of the facilities as well as to assist Lifeguard Staff with enforcement of facility rules and regulations; and
- Other duties as required.

Desired Qualifications for this position:

- Have experience operating one or more of the following pieces of equipment: farm tractor (offset mower, front loader, and backhoe attachment), zero turn mower, chainsaws, gas trimmers and other equipment to maintain grounds;
- Capable of performing general labour duties i.e. shoveling, raking, clearing brush, mowing, sign post installation etc.;
- Have skills in one of the following: carpentry, painting, landscaping, or other;
- Must have a valid driver's license and be able to provide driver's abstract if contacted for an interview;
- You are a dependable person with strong people skills and a team player;
- Ability to swim, WHMIS/First Aid training, and experience with facility operations, are considered assets.

This is a seasonal unionized position governed in accordance with the Collective Agreement between the Municipality of the County of Kings and CUPE, Local 2618-01. Compensation includes a competitive salary and vacation pay. Salary will be Level 1 of the Municipal Pay Band \$17.67/hr - \$20.09/hr.

Hours of work (beginning of May – mid June): Monday through Friday 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM

Hours of work (mid-June – September): alternating 4 days one week, 3 days the next / 12 hours per day (Monday – Sunday schedule).
